








PRINT LIKE ALICE AUSTIN

BOOK SCULPTURES


ALICE AUSTIN's books twist, pop, fold, and stretch.

Some of Mayo's flowers: Orchid, bog cotton primrose, foxglove, heather, buttercup, ox-eye daisy, wood anemone, sundew, milkwort, marsh pea, dandelion, lesser celandine, thistle and butterwort.












DESIGN A MAYO DAY BOOK COVER
